

WMRC uses the MyLaps (formerly AMB) Timing system for Timing and Scoring. Participants are required to use a compatible transponder during race events (not needed for WMRC track days).

There are 3 compatible options available:

- TranX 260
- X2 Car/Bike
- TR2 Car/Bike.

All 3 options are available in a hard-wired configuration or rechargeable battery powered unit.



The TranX 260 transponder is an older style but is still supported. It is not available from MyLaps. You may find used ones on eBay or elsewhere.



The X2 Car/Bike transponder is a subscription based offering available new from MyLaps or used elsewhere. It has features the WMRC is not utilizing at this time.



The TR2 Car/Bike transponder is also a subscription based offering available new from MyLaps or used elsewhere. It has fewer features than the X2.

*The transponder is mounted vertically on a fork tube no more than 4' above the ground. Line of sight between the transponder and the ground is required for best performance. Metal or carbon fiber between the transponder and the ground will result in poor (or no) results.*

**Note: Kart transponders (i.e. TranX 160, X2 Kart or TR2 Kart) are not acceptable. Kart transponders are for lower speeds and installation only 4"-6" above the ground.**
